MINUTES

YOUTH COMMISSION MEETING TUESDAY, DECEMBER 10, 2013 -7:00 P. M. TOWN COUNCIL CHAMBERS

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by XinNi Chai to approve the meeting minutes of November 12, 2013. **Seconded** by Crystal Huang. **All in Favor**

VERBAL COMMUNICATION

There were no verbal communications at this meeting.

ITEMS OF DISCUSSION

Facebook - (Matt Mingrone/Henry Strickland) Claire Strickland commented that Facebook should either be maintained or deleted. Suggested that the committee use a task list to better maintain the Facebook page.

Instagram Update (Crystal Huang/Anne Zepecki) Crystal Huang and Anne Zepecki commented that they have posted pictures from the parade and asked that the Commission continue to forward them more pictures of events and student related projects.

Cyber Bullying Claire Strickland commented that the sub-committee will begin in January 2014 with the cyber bullying project. Ms. Zepecki will take the lead on updates.

Chief commented that the commission could request a vehicle like the dump truck or flatbed from PPW for the Commission to use in the parade next year.

Update on Design and Cost for Commission T-shirts Molly commented that the sub-committee has designed a logo for a navy blue LGYC sweatshirt with Town logo. Suggested that the sweatshirt have graduation dates listed on the back. Chief asked that the committee come back to him with a final cost for the sweatshirts.

Youth Friendly Business Program Claire commented that the Youth Commission should continue with the YFB program and that the first thing to do would be to update the list of participants.

Visit Neighboring Youth Commissions Claire suggested that the commission visit Saratoga, San Jose, and Cupertino in the upcoming months. Chief suggested that if any Commissioners would like to attend other commissions that have meetings that are on the same night, they can let him know and it could be counted as attending a LGYC meeting.

Los Gatos High School Traffic and Safety Committee Update Molly Ball commented that the committee discussed alternative parking options such as the parking lot at Balzer field, the LG Lodge parking lot, carpooling, and the option to issue less permits at the high school.
