ITEMS OF DISCUSSION

Item #2 - Spring into Green Presentation/Request

Ms. Zepecki made a presentation about the Town's Spring into Green event in April. She asked if there were 8-10 YC members interested in participating by hosting a kid's activity booth. Mr. Seaman, Mr. Zudin, Ms. Zepecki, Ms. Huang, and Ms. Vodsky formed a sub-committee to bring back ideas to the YC at the March YC meeting.

Item #3 - Smoking Ordinance Amendment – Anne Zepecki

Ms. Zepecki made an update on the commissions outreach efforts. She commented that for the most part everyone they talked to was agreeable to the amendments and the hotels were in support of the amendment. As for apartments, two out of six answered and stated that smoking was banned on their premises already.

Opened Public Comment

Dr. Weissman commented that the smoking ordinance amendment is scheduled to go before Council on March 15, 2016 and he suggested that the entire YC be in attendance to show their support.

Closed Public Comment

Ms. Zepecki requested assistance to make presentation at the Council meeting. Shomik Jain and Sawye Raygani offered to work with the Town Attorney on a presentation to Council. Ms. Rose will work with them to set-up a meeting time with Mr. Schultz.

Item #4 - Public Relations for Teens in the Library – Heidi Murphy

Ms. Murphy made presentation on the topic and requested suggestions from the YC. Suggestions included:

- Display noisy times. Have display that states this is current noise level.
- Partner with YC on getting the word out using social media.
- Positive marketing to high school and Library.
- Change up current sound zone signs.

Ms. Murphy requested forming a sub-committee to work on ideas and marketing.

Item #5 - Traffic Sub-Committee – Crystal Huang

Ms. Huang made a brief presentation and will work with Ms. Rose to set-up a meeting with Mr. Morley, PPW Director for March.

Item # 6 - Social Media Subcommittee – Anne Zepecki

Ms. Zepecki commented on marketing to promote YC applicants. She commented that the YC should reach out to Fisher Middle School and distribute through the Library. Ms. Raygani offered to create a flyer for distribution.

Item #7 - Youth Center Sub-Committee – Charlotte Pla

Ms. Zepecki commented that the Under 21 club has reached out to partner with the YC to hold a movie night or BBQ. Commented that they may talk to the New Museum Association on the possibility to hold an event at the museum in April. Commented on creating a sub-committee for this project.
